CHARACTER TUBE PUPPET

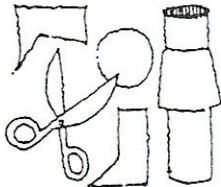
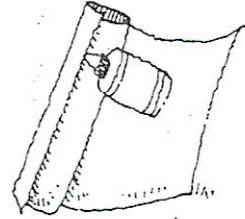
Read a great picture book or a short chapter book together and present the main character as a tube puppet. The character may be a person or animal, or even an object, such as a robot. You may want to read the book twice.

GETTING STARTED:

Think about the size you want to make your puppet, then find a cardboard tube from bathroom tissue, paper towels, or wrapping paper. You'll need colored paper to cover the tube and to create clothes, feet, arms, hat, etc.; glue; markers or crayons.

MAKING YOUR PROJECT:

1. Find a cardboard tube and cover it with paper. Choose a good background color, or use white paper for the first layer.



2. Now cut out pieces of paper to glue to the tube to make the character's head, arms, feet, and other features such as hair, eyes, and clothing. Leave about a third of the tube for a handle, so you can control your puppet.

3. Add details with markers. Attach decorative items, such as yarn or movable eyes. Attach all pieces to the tube with glue or tape.
