

Summer Reading Projects
for Students Entering Grade 8

Students will prepare a written report for each of the three books read. The three format choices for the reports are

A. Book Report Form

B. Write a summary of what you learned from the book. The summary might include factual information, something you learned about people in general, or something you learned about yourself.

C. Create a chart with three columns. Each column is headed with the name of one of the book's characters. As you read the book, keep a record of the traits each character possesses. Rate each characteristic as positive (+) or negative (-). Be prepared to explain your evaluation of this trait during a class discussion.

You must do one of each kind of report by matching Choice A with one book, Choice B with another book and Choice C with the last. You decide which format matches which book the best.
